As part of the LOGOS *Leader In Training* (LIT) ministry, youth have the opportunity to volunteer with adult leaders in the church as part of a particular LOGOS Leadership Team to facilitate ministry. GECKOS is the 1st-5th grade group, while Chrysalis is for middle-schoolers.

Expectations: In addition to participating as a leader as outlined in the LIT program handbook, LITs will be expected to attend Training Sessions for this ministry and will meet periodically with the SCPC Staff person who serves as their Supervisor.

Age Requirement: Youth must be at least three years older than oldest youth in the group.

What is LOGOS?

The LOGOS Program is a dynamic Tuesday night children & youth ministry at State College Presbyterian Church. Our goal is to nurture youth and children in a personal relationship with one another, members of our congregation, the community and ultimately encourage youth to grow in faith and as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

The LOGOS Program is a four-part program (Activity Time, Bible Time, Family Time and Worship Skills). All youth and children participate in all four parts of the LOGOS Program each week. Adult leaders participate in the part of the program in which they have been called to share their gifts.

GECKOS is our LOGOS ministry for children in grades 1 through 5. It meets on Tuesday from 4:00-7:00pm, providing a structured program that builds relationships with peers, Christian adults, the congregation and Christ.

Chrysalis is the middle-school (grades 6-8) segment of the ministry. It meets on Tuesday from 5:00-8:00pm. It provides the youth with a nurturing environment in which to build relationships while learning about their faith. In addition to regular Tuesday night programming, Chrysalis has a Fall Retreat and a Spring Lock-In.

The **four parts of the LOGOS Program** (Activity Time, Worship Skills, Bible Time and Family Time) are designed to create an environment in which all can practice, through their relationships a variety of theological concepts learned in Scripture. The program enables youth, children, and leaders to experience God's unconditional love, and to learn to share that love with their peers, adult leaders, and their families.

The four parts are designed to reflect the life of the early church as expressed in

Acts 2:42:

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and prayers.

When is LOGOS?

When? The SCPC LOGOS Program generally runs from the middle of September (beginning with a picnic for all) to the middle of April (ending with a LOGOS Celebration). There are Thanksgiving, Winter, Spring and Summer Breaks. Otherwise, LOGOS is making noise and dancing with the Spirit on Tuesday nights at SCPC!
