We are looking for:



Adult Explorations for January Meets at 10:15 am Following Worship

January 7 ~ "The Epiphany in Art", led by Heather Bruhn, in Westminster Hall

The word "epiphany" signifies "the sudden realization or comprehension of the (larger) essence or meaning of something". In Christianity, Epiphany celebrates the revelation of Christ to the Magi, and ultimately, the gentile world. Art historian Heather Bruhn leads us through an exploration of how the Epiphany of Christ has been represented in art.

January 14 ~ "The Bible Project" led by Bob Igo in Westminster Hall

Many people have misunderstood the Bible as a collection of inspirational quotes or a divine instruction manual. Most of us gravitate toward sections we enjoy while avoiding parts that are confusing or even disturbing.
