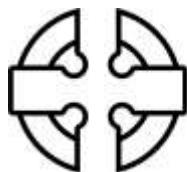

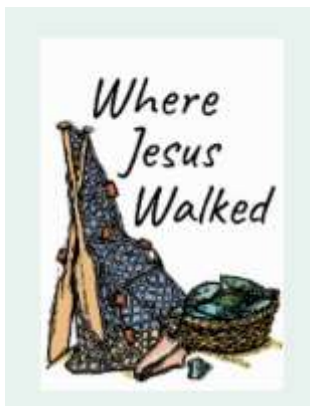
church to carpool. If carpooling, please be at SCPC by 8:30 am. The drive will take approximately 35-40 minutes. If driving directly, starting at the church, drive to Nittany Mall; when the road splits, with the mall in the center, take the right, East College Ave, (26N) towards Pleasant Gap, continue past Hublersburg and on to Lamar. About 6 miles beyond the mall, route 26N turns to the left. At that location take route 64, which continues straight ahead. Continue for about 11 miles and turn right onto route 445. Continue on 445, which is a very twisty road, for about four miles. Turn right into the camp property when you see the sign for Krislund Camp and Conference Center. Follow the dirt road for about one mile and meet at the camp office on your left.

There are alternate routes, if you're following GPS. The address for the camp is 189 Krislund Drive, Madisonburg, PA 16852. We may take lunches to eat there outside, if weather allows. If you have any questions, please contact Sharon at 814-466-6098 or 814-571-4059. Be aware that cell phone service at the Camp is intermittent.

Dress for the weather, bring water, and consider sunscreen and/or bug/tick spray.

We usually walk in light rain, but will cancel if the weather is stormy. Look for any cancellation information due to weather conditions on SCPC Facebook and via e-mail.

**Hekima Place** ~ As you know from updates in worship and your Thursday emails, Hekima Place needs our prayers. Dangerous travel conditions forced classes to be canceled at the school for a number of days, but **we are happy to share that classes have reopened!** We believe that the farm (the shamba, which provides much of their nutritious food) is still closed.

For those wishing to stay current as the situation continues to change, Hekima staff are posting periodic updates on their Facebook and Instagram accounts. Both accounts are posting the same material, and both are [linked at the bottom of the Hekima Place website](#), ([hekimaplace.org](http://hekimaplace.org)) While Hekima's blog, newsletter, and website are being updated less frequently during this time, Hekima Place's social media posts are public – anyone can view them, including people without Facebook or Instagram accounts.

The Social Justice and Mission Team has voted to send \$1600 to Hekima to use as needed in this time of emergency and, we pray soon, recovery. We are able to do this because of the Powers Fund for Mission, established by Jim and Sue Powers (now Sue Martz), which is split between mission needs in Centre County, and mission needs beyond. We are grateful!

**Board of Deacons**

Deacons are elected officers who serve three year terms.
