Operating: pledged or "general" giving Deacons: contributions for the Deacons

Other Gifts: for special collections (unless otherwise directed or a special line is set up). When using this option, please use the Memo line to indicate what program, etc. you are supporting.

Stay & Play Donations: contributions for the Stay & Play program. This link *cannot* be used if you are a S&P family paying tuition. This is for tax-deductible contributions only.

Peace and Global Witness 2021: *NEW*: this option is for our upcoming Peace and Global Witness collection (see the Mission article for more info) and will not be active once this collection time as passed.

LOGOS Program Fees: *NEW*: this link is for LOGOS program fees *only* and *is not* tax deductible.

FISH Program Fees: *NEW*: this link is for FISH program fees *only* and *is not* tax deductible.

When using the Online Giving system, you are always welcome to click the button to increase your gift by 2% and offset the processing fees we incur.

Adult Education in October

Title: LGBTQIA+ Experiences and Faith

Date: October 10, 2021 Location: Westminster Hall

Description: In honor of National Coming Out Day, our church community will devote some much-needed space to discussing LGBTQIA+ experiences with faith. Title: The Dead Sea Scolls and the Bible - Findings and Forgeries

Description: The discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls in the 1940s and 50s gives us unprecedented insight into the development of scripture. Our very own Daniel Falk, who is Head of the Department of Classics and Ancient Mediterranean Studies at Penn State, will discuss some more recent findings from these scrolls, including biblical fragments in the Cave of Horrors and forgeries purchased by the Museum of the Bible.

fríday:


Pray for the Church around the world, for missionaries, for the extending of God's Kingdom.
