For your convenience items can be dropped here at SCPC at the parking lot, or rear of the sanctuary entrance.

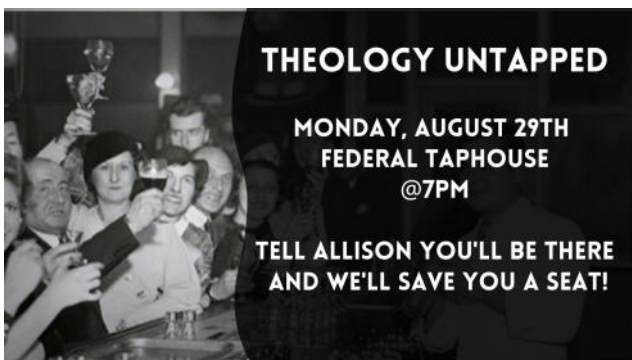
Make Your Plans to Attend the "Raisin' Cane with LOGOS" Gathering
