Church Picnic 2023 ~ July 16

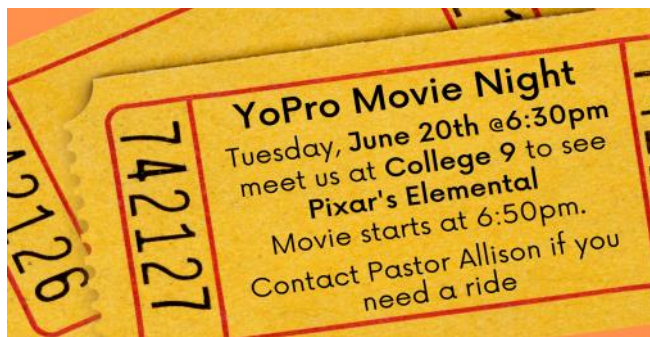
