Please join Nancy Spooner as she shares on "The Challenges of Incarceration: What's it REALLY Like on the Inside?" How do the 3,000+ men and women who are incarcerated in Centre County's three correctional facilities experience daily life, including a 6'x9' cell, questionable food quality, restricted medical care, solitary confinement, limited family involvement, violence, and human rights violations? What opportunities exist for us to make a difference? Nancy Spooner will share her 5+ years of experience as an Official Visitor with the PA Prison Society, a group that advocates for the rights and well-being of the incarcerated. This discussion will take place in Westminster Hall today after service.
